

Parish Boundaries

Parish Boundaries of St. Mary's Parish, Potsdam

Between Potsdam and Hopkinton

The boundary begins where NY11B intersects the West Stockholm-Southville Road, and follows the West Stockholm-Southville Road (CR 57) north to the Fearl Bridge Road, then northeast on the Fearl Bridge Road to the Old Market Road. All families on both sides of the sections of roads in the aforementioned description belong to Hopkinton Parish.

Between Potsdam and Parishville

The boundary begins where the Russell Turnpike Road intersects the Colton-Parishville Road and Ashton Road and goes north on Ashton Road, crosses 72 to continue on Sinclair Road, then east along Allen Falls Road upon crossing the Old Potsdam-Parishville Road. The boundary follows Allen Falls Road to the West Branch of the St. Regis River, then north along the river to NY 11B, which it follows east to the West Stockholm-Southville Road. All houses on the sections of roads in the aforementioned description belong to Parishville.

Between Potsdam and Brasher Falls

The boundary is the Old Market Road from its intersection by the Fearl Bridge Road north to US11, then west on US11 to cross the river, and then north again onto the continuation of Old Market Road to its intersection with Pickle Street.

Between Potsdam and Norwood

Beginning at the intersection of Old Market Road and Pickle Street, the boundary follows Pickle Street southwest to US11, and then follows US11 as far as the Potsdam-Stockholm town line (all houses on these road segments belong to Potsdam). The boundary is then the same as the Potsdam-Stockholm town line north and west to the Pleasant Valley Road, which it follows west to NY56 (all houses on this road segment belong to Potsdam). It follows NY56 north to the intersection with Sissonville Road (all houses on NY56 belong to Norwood), then Sissonville Road west and south to Hewittville Road, which it follows west over the river to the intersection with River Road. The boundary then follows River Road north to the intersection with Barker Road, then southwest on Barker Road to the intersection with NY345 (all houses on these road segments belong to Norwood). It then follows NY345 northwest two miles to the intersection with CR35 (all houses on this segment of NY345 belong to Potsdam).

Between Potsdam and Madrid

The boundary is the segment of CR35 (Moore's Corners – Burnhams Corners Road) south from NY345 to CR34 (West Potsdam Road). All houses on this segment of road belong to Potsdam.

Between Potsdam and Canton

The boundary is the segment of CR35 (Corners – Burnhams Corners Road) south from the intersection with CR34 (West Potsdam Road) to the Trout Brook (all houses on this road segment belong to Potsdam). Then boundary then follows Trout Brook south to within one mile of US11 where an east tributary meets Wright Road. The boundary follows Wright Road south across US11 where it becomes Crary Mills –Eben Road, then continues straight across S. Canton Road when the road becomes Anderson Road to the intersection with Parmenter Road. Houses on this road with odd address numbers belong to Canton and even numbers to Potsdam.

Between Potsdam and Colton

The boundary follows Parmenter Road from its intersection with Anderson Road to where it intersects Back Hannawa Road, then continues on a straight line from that intersection to the Racquette River (all house on this segment of Parmenter Road belong to Potsdam Parish). The boundary then follows the Racquette River south and east to Brown's Bridge Road, which it then follows northeast and continues northeast on Russel Turnpike Road as far as the intersection with the Colton-Parishville Road. All houses on this segment of the Russel Turnpike Road belong to Potsdam.

Parish Boundaries of St. Patrick's Parish, Colton

Between Colton and Potsdam

The boundary follows Parmenter Road from its intersection with Anderson Road to where it intersects Back Hannawa Road, then continues on a straight line from that intersection to the Racquette River (all house on this segment of Parmenter Road belong to Potsdam Parish). The boundary then follows the Racquette River south and east to Brown's Bridge Road, which it then follows northeast and continues northeast on Russel Turnpike Road as far as the intersection with the Colton-Parishville Road. All houses on this segment of the Russel Turnpike Road belong to Potsdam.

Between Colton and Canton

The boundary begins at the intersection of Parmenter Road and Anderson Road, following Anderson Road southeast to where it meets the Potsdam town line. All houses on this road segment belong to Colton. It then follows the Potsdam town line southwest to Howardville Road, and then follows Howardville Road south to the Pierrepont-Clare Road (CR24). All houses on this segment belong to Canton. It then follows the Pierrepont-Clare Road southwest to the

intersection with the Clare Road (CR27) which it follows south to where it meets the north branch of the Grass River. All houses on these road segments belong to Canton.

Between Colton and Fine

The boundary follows the north branch of the Grass River from the Clare Road east to the Clare-Colton town line. It then follows this town line south as far as the Clifton town line.

Between Colton and Star Lake

The boundary follows the Clifton town line east and south to the Bog Road, then follows the Bog Road east as far as NY56, which it then follows south to Fallon Brook. All houses on these road segments belong to Colton.

Between Colton and Piercefield

The boundary follows Fallon Brook east from NY56 to the Racquette River, then the Racquette River east to the Piercefield town line, then the town line north and east to the Franklin county line.

Between Colton and Saranac Lake? This is the east boundary

The boundary begins where the Piercefield town line meets the Franklin County line, and follows the Franklin county line north as far as the Lake Ozonia Road.

Between Parishville and Hopkinton

The boundary begins where NY11B intersects with the West Southville-Stockholm Road, and proceeds east along NY11B as far as the intersection with Elliot Road. The boundary then turns south to parallel Elliot Road (it follows what would be the extension of Elliott Road on a straight line past NY11B) until it meets CR56, which it follows east to NY72. The boundary then follows NY72 southwest a short distance to Santmont Road, then follows Santmont Road south to Cutler Road. The boundary then follows Cutler Road east, then Beebe Road south to where it ends at a creek. The boundary then follows this creek northeast to where it meets Lyde Brook, and follows Lyde Brook east and south to where it meets an unnamed road. The boundary follows this unnamed road east to Lake Ozonia Road, and follows Lake Ozonia Road east to where it meets the Franklin County Line. All houses on these road segments belong to Hopkinton.

Legacy Boundaries Within St. Patrick's

Between Colton and South Colton

The boundary begins where the Russel Turnpike Road crosses the Van Rensselaer Creek and follows the creek east and south to Wilson Road. It then follows Wilson Road east until that road comes to a T intersection, then continues on a straight line to the Pierrepont town line.

The boundary then follows the Pierrepont town line north to where it crosses Hanson Road, which it then follows east to Gulf Road, then north on Gulf Road to Pine Road, then east on Pine Road and then northeast to cross the river at Higley Falls. **The boundary follows the road to NY56**, then follows NY56 southeast to the Number 9 Road. It then follows the Number 9 Road east to the French Hill Road, which it follows north to the Parishville town line, which it follows east until the town line turns south. The boundary continues on a straight line east to meet Picketville Road, which it follows north to the Alder Meadow Brook.

Between Colton and Parishville

The boundary begins where the Colton-Parishville Road meets the Russell Turnpike Road, and follows the Colton Parishville Road south to Rodwell Mill Road (also known as the Christy Road or Seven Springs Road). It then follows the Rodwell Mill Road east to where it intersects French Hill Road, which it follows south a short distance to its intersection with Crowley Road. The boundary then follows Crowley Road south and east to where it dead-ends, then the boundary continues on a straight line to the point on the Picketville Road where it crosses the Alder Meadow Brook. All houses along these road segments belong to Colton.

Between South Colton and Parishville

The boundary begins where the Alder Meadow Brook meets the Picketville Road, and follows the Alder Meadow Brook east to where it meets the Parishville town line. The boundary then follows the Parishville town line south and east to White Hill Road, and follows White Hill Road south to **where Joe Indian Pond drains into the Racquette River – not sure I understood this properly**. It then follows the Racquette River south to the Parishville town line, and then the Parishville town line east and north to the West Branch of the Saint Regis River. The boundary then follows the West Branch of the Saint Regis River southeast to the Franklin County Line. All houses on these road segments belong to Parishville.

Parish Boundaries of Holy Cross Parish, Hopkinton

Between Potsdam and Hopkinton

The boundary begins where NY11B intersects the West Stockholm-Southville Road, and follows the West Stockholm-Southville Road (CR 57) north to the Fearl Bridge Road, then northeast on the Fearl Bridge Road to the Old Market Road. All families on both sides of the sections of roads in the aforementioned description belong to Hopkinton Parish.

Between Parishville and Hopkinton

The boundary begins where NY11B intersects with the West Southville-Stockholm Road, and proceeds east along NY11B as far as the intersection with Elliot Road. The boundary then turns south to parallel Elliot Road (it follows what would be the extension of Elliott Road on a straight

line past NY11B) until it meets CR56, which it follows east to NY72. The boundary then follows NY72 southwest a short distance to Santmont Road, then follows Santmont Road south to Cutler Road. The boundary then follows Cutler Road east, then Beebe Road south to where it ends at a creek. The boundary then follows this creek northeast to where it meets Lyde Brook, and follows Lyde Brook east and south to where it meets an unnamed road. The boundary follows this unnamed road east to Lake Ozonia Road, and follows Lake Ozonia Road east to where it meets the Franklin County Line. All houses on these road segments belong to Hopkinton.

Between Hopkinton and St. Regis Falls

The boundary is the Franklin County line.

Between Hopkinton and Brasher Falls

The boundary begins where the Fearl Bridge Road intersects the Old Market Road, and follows the Fearl Bridge Road east to where it intersects the Southville-Holmes Hill Road. It follows the Southville-Holmes Hill Road north a short distance to the intersection with Buckton Road, and then follows the Buckton Road northeast to where it meets the Fort Jackson-Winthrop Road. All houses on these road segments belong to Brasher Falls.

Between Hopkinton and North Lawrence

The boundary begins where the Willis Schoolhouse-Wagstaff Corners Road meets the Fort Jackson-Winthrop Road, and follows the Willis Schoolhouse-Wagstaff Corners Road northeast to where it intersects Merchant Road. The boundary then follows Merchant Road south to its intersection with Shinnock Road, then Shinnock Road east to McEwan Road, then McEwan Road north to Allen Brook. The boundary then follows Allen Brook southeast to CR55, then CR55 south to an unnamed crossroad which leads southeast to US11B (all houses on the preceding road segments belong to North Lawrence). The boundary follows this crossroad to US11B, then US11B to the Franklin County Line. All houses on this crossroad and US11B belong to Hopkinton.
